

PGD (1)1 Jennings Romainville Kiefer, good width to head and powerful foreface. Round eye and neat ears. Moderate and muscular neck and longer than high with rise to strong loin. Slight turnout to front feet and well boned. Nicely made at rear, with rounded bottom and well set tail. Moved freely and with drive. RBD.

OD (2,1)1 Hannington's Eng/Bel/Dut/Int /Esp Ch Boudivella Osca VW. Head of good length, broad in skull, defined stop and strong, powerful muzzle. Slight crook to forelegs with correct foot position and strong in bone. Imposing, workmanlike profile, longer than high. Well ribbed, strong loin rising to powerful rear. Harsh red wheaten jacket with soft undercoat. True and free on the move. BD and BOS.

PB (2)1 Hannington's Boudivella Fire Cracker JW, and a wee cracker she is, blue in lovely order, good length and texture to coat. Head developing well, with width in skull and strength in foreface. Small ears and round in eye. Liked her overall body shape and correct topline. Moved freely and actively. BPB & BP.

2 Jennings Slievenabrehan Neala (IKC) this baby not as well developed for width in head just yet but good for eye shape and ears small. Feminine and hardy, decent bone and feet. Slightly rising topline and moved with activity.

OB (2)1 Forbes' Ch Jeonty Dreams A Dream With Karensbrae JW ShCEx OSW, game, feminine and of substance. Liked her head for shape and strength in jaw. Neck well muscled into well laid shoulder, strong bone and slightly turned out compact feet. Good depth to chest and well sprung ribbing, slightly rising topline and nicely rounded at rear. Harsh red wheaten jacket with soft undercoat and fairly powered round the ring. BB & BOB.

2 Hannington's Boudivella Rosie JW, another strong and feminine typy bitch. Also pleased for head, neck and body outline. Rising topline also as required. Again, width and depth to chest and decent bone. Front feet just turning out a little more than ideal I felt. Blue with correct coat and undercoat and free mover. RBB.
