

PGD (1) 1 Bailey's Zippor Brendan. Pleasing make and shape with a typical outlook. Good strength of head along with a good eye and expression. Strong neck, well sprung ribs, correct topline and good width of hindquarters. Moved soundly on a good stride.

LD (2) 1 Withers Panjantick Darknite. Well made dog, liked his size and balance along with his firm topline with that slight rise to loin that the standard asks for. Pleasing head and expression. Well made front assembly and strong quarters. Positive on the move.

2 George's Romainville Rock It Ronnie. Different stamp and style to the winner. Excellent strength throughout with good bone and substance. Pleasing eye and expression, well ribbed and nicely rounded hindquarters. Not as positive on the move as the winner.

OD (3) 1 Hardy's Ch Amhard Quick Fire. Dog of excellent confirmation throughout and took top honours on the day with his very sound and effortless movement along with a typical appearance. Pleasing head, good layback of shoulder, strong chest and powerful quarters that he uses to advantage on the move. Presented in the best of coats on the day. CC.

2 Alstead's Ch Golden Spurs. At 10 years old he belies his age and has kept a great make and shape both stood and on the move. Typical in head, neat well set ears and good strength of foreface. Good body shape, well sprung ribs and a good tailset and carriage. Sound on the move, Res CC.

3 Salleti & Hall's Esp Ch World Heremon Bear at Jojase.

VD/B (2,1) 1 Alstead's Int Ch/Ch Sigrid Helga at Pantcottage. Presents such a typical appearance. Liked her size, feminine but has the strength and substance to complete the picture. Good head, well set ears, alert expression and good strength of jaw. Pleasing front assembly, strong hindquarters. Moved well, BV.

JB (3,1) 1 Hannington's Boudivella Rosie. Was very taken with this youngster. Typey bitch, medium size as the standard asks for and strongly made throughout. Best of heads with a good eye and expression. Well made front assembly, pleasing body for her age and a correct topline and tailset. Good quarters and a pleasing bend of stifle. Positive on the move, Res CC.

2 Howarth's Amhard Sugar Plum. Just out of puppy and not the maturity of the winner on the day. Pleasing make and shape. Balanced head with a very typical outlook and the best of expressions. Good depth of chest for her age, pleasing topline and tailset. Moved well on a good stride. Just needs time.

PGB (3,2) 1 Saletti's Marfidal Storm at Boudivella (Imp Fin). Pleasing type of good strength and substance but is not overdone in anyway. Good eye shape and colour. Strong neck, pleasing legs and feet, firm body and well sprung ribs. Good width of hindquarters. Sound on the move.

LB (4) 1 Hannington's Mo Stor of Tatler Jack's Clan at Boudivella (Imp Nld). Liked her a lot and was close up for top honours on the day. Pleasing shape, well balanced and presents a very typical outlook. Good head piece, neat ears and the best of expressions. Well made front, correct topline and a good bend of stifle. Moved soundly on a free and easy stride.

2 George's Romainville Classy N Sassy. Excellent strength throughout, quality bone and presented in the best of coats. Good head and eye. Strong muscular neck set in well placed shoulders. Pleasing spring of rib, firm loin and powerful well rounded quarters. Sound and positive mover.

3 Saletti's Jojase Aisling Pixie.

OB (5,2) 1 Sage's Ch Wickholm Bohemian Rhapsody. Quality bitch who took your eye as soon as she entered the ring, great attitude and confidence. Liked her size and fits the standard well, 'great strength with impression of maximum substance for the size of dog'. Best of heads, good width and strong foreface. Excellent front assembly, correct topline and tailset and good width of hindquarters and a pleasing bend of stifle. Soundest of movers fore and aft with good drive from behind, CC & BOB.

2 George's Romainville China Blue. Another good one from this kennel. Presents a very balanced appearance and put down in first class order on the day. Typical in head with a lovely eye and expression. Stands on good legs and feet. Muscular neck and a good layback of shoulder. Firm topline and a good tailset and carriage. Moved well on a good stride.
